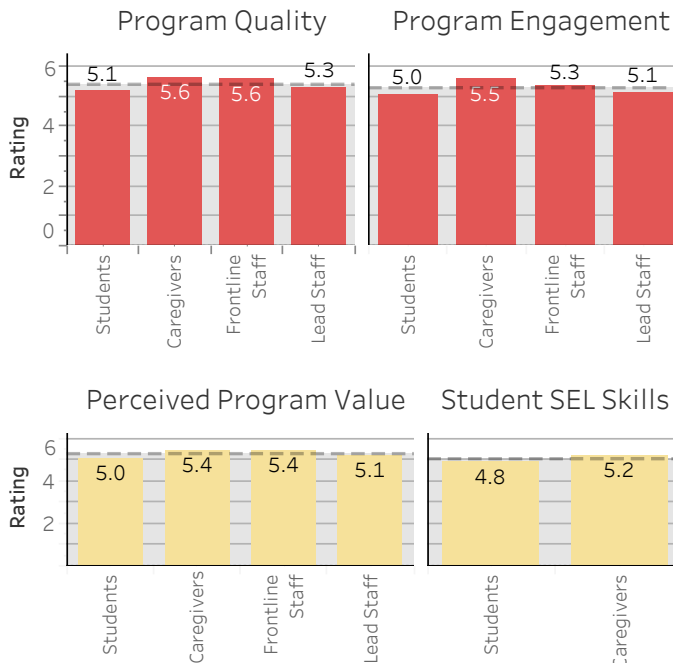

Survey Results

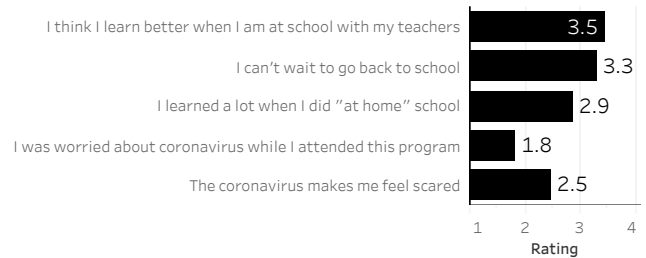
These questions are based on a 6-point scale from (1) Strongly Disagree, (2) Disagree, (3) Somewhat Disagree, (4) Somewhat Agree, (5) Agree, and (6) Strongly Agree. The dotted line in the graphs represent the average score across participants. *Note: The Student Survey was primarily based on a 4-point scale, unlike the other surveys that are based on a 6-point scale. For purposes of comparing responses across surveys, the student responses were recalculated to match the 6-point scale.*



COVID-19 Feedback

To assess how COVID-19 has impacted students, they were asked to answer the following set of questions. The "Student Perspectives" questions are based on a 4-point scale from (1) Strongly Disagree, (2) Disagree, (3) Agree, and (4) Strongly Agree. The "Technology Access & Social Connection" questions were based on "yes-no" answer choices. These represent the number of students that said "yes" to the question.
